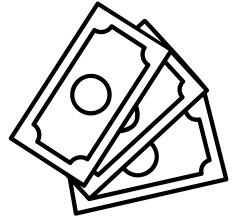
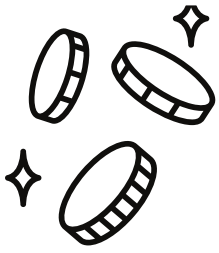


PHRASAL VERBS – MONEY

DEFINITION	PHRASAL VERB
To repay a debt in full.	
To charge someone too much money or cheat them financially.	
To pay money for something, usually unwillingly.	
To keep money for a specific purpose over time.	
To spend a lot of money on something, often luxuriously or unnecessarily.	
To finish all of something, so that there is none left.	
To manage to live or survive financially, often with difficulty.	
to save something, usually time or money, for a special purpose	
to return money that you borrowed from somebody	
To reduce spending or consumption.
