DEFINITION	PHRASAL VERB
to visit a place and look at the things in it	look around
to leave a hotel after paying and returning your room key	check out
to go to the place that someone is leaving from in order to say goodbye to them	see off
to go onto a bus, train, aircraft, or boat	get on
to report your arrival, esp. at an airport or hotel, so that you can get the service you are paying for	check in
to return to the place where you started from or were before	head back
to leave the ground and begin to fly	take off
an act of taking someone or something to a particular place, usually by car, and leaving them there	drop off
to land at an airport	touch down
to go somewhere to have a holiday, often because you need to rest	get away
