DEFINITION	PHRASAL VERB
to visit a place and look at the things in it	
to leave a hotel after paying and returning your room key	
to go to the place that someone is leaving from in order to say goodbye to them	
to go onto a bus, train, aircraft, or boat	
to report your arrival, esp. at an airport or hotel, so that you can get the service you are paying for	
to return to the place where you started from or were before	
to leave a hotel after paying and returning your room key	
an act of taking someone or something to a particular place, usually by car, and leaving them there	
to land at an airport	
to go somewhere to have a holiday, often because you need to rest
